

6th International Violin Competition Henri Marteau – Application until January 31, 2017

From April 24 until May 6, 2017 the 6th International Violin Competition Henri Marteau takes place in Lichtenberg and Hof. The Hofer Symphoniker (Hof symphony orchestra) assumed again the artistic and organizational general direction of the competition. The international jury with Gilbert Varga as chairman for the fourth time consists of renowned professors, soloists and personalities of the musical life. Media partner is again the Bayerische Rundfunk, which will produce a broadcast production and a CD recording with the first prize winner. The laureates receive cash awards with a total of €35.000, the loan of a valuable violin and scholarships for master classes.

Numerous applications from all over the world already arrived in the competition office of the Hofer Symphoniker. Violinists who are not older than 25 years at the time of the competition can apply online until January 31, 2017.
